SUBJECT: Update re: January 8, 2019, Service Disruption

The Division of Statewide Emergency Telecommunications, in conjunction with AT&T and Frontier Communications, have investigated and identified the cause of yesterday's disruption to the 911 system. The following is a brief explanation from Frontier Communications.

A planned Change Management Operation by Frontier, on Tuesday, January 8, 2019, resulted in a disruption of calls to the 911 system in Connecticut shortly after 1 a.m. ET. The change was rolled back and all services restored by 2:45 a.m.

- A network configuration change between network services providers was being implemented by Frontier on Tuesday morning and a discovered anomaly caused a temporary disruption of calls to PSAPs in Connecticut at 01:09 Tuesday morning.
- Network engineers observed the disruption, responded to correct the issue and services were restored by 02:45.
- At this time, it has not been determined how many calls may have been affected. Frontier performs required maintenance operations during hours of minimal system use, in this case after midnight.
- The disruption was caused by a configuration error.

The stability and reliability of the 911 system are critical; we take this matter very seriously and are making every effort to ensure that this does not recur.
