Connecticut Chapter of the FBI National Academy Associates will be hosting its annual re-trainer at The Gallery, 141 New London Turnpike, Glastonbury, CT 06033.



### **GUEST SPEAKER**

Dr. M. Saud Anwar is also the founder and current Co-Chair of American Muslim Peace Initiative (AMPI). AMPI work includes strengthening the intra-faith and interfaith understanding within Islam and between Islam and other religions. AMPI work has included help and support to under privileged communities in United States, and peace missions to Middle East and South Asia.

Dr. Anwar's activities and volunteerism to coordinate a response in the aftermath of September 11th earned him official recognition from the American Red Cross. He has testified to the 109th Congress for the Committee on Homeland Security about the American Muslim Community. He has also testified to the State of Connecticut legislature on multiple occasions. Dr. Anwar was a part of team of experts to help work with the Department of Homeland Security and the British Department of Communities and Local Government to evaluate the challenges of extremism in UK and allowed him to interview extremists and processes of their rehabilitation. He has been the Chief Coordinator of a Conference on Radicalization and Understanding DeRadicalization strategies in Hartford, CT. He has been a Conference Speaker for the Department of Homeland Security and consulting speaker for the office of Secretary Napolitano.

Dr. Anwar has been a part of Peace missions to Israel and Middle East, Diplomatic Missions on US- Pakistan Relations, Medical Mission- Haiti Disaster Relief after the earthquake and Medical Mission- Pakistan Earthquake Response, where he met with US armed forces involved in recovery efforts. He is the recipient of the Director FBI-Robert Mueller III Award for Community Leadership and Alliance Building.

He has served as Chair of the Human Relations Commission for the town of South Windsor and member of the States Commission for the Asian Pacific American Community. For his services to the immigrant communities as well as to the State of Connecticut in his various roles his work has been recognized by the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, Attorney General, Secretary of State and many legislators of the Connecticut General Assembly.

Dr. Anwar has served on the South Windsor Town Council since 2011, including a term as Mayor, when his leadership brought 243 new jobs in a single year to the town as opposed to 44 jobs in previous 10 years.

In addition, Dr. Anwar is an expert on international affairs. He is frequently invited to appear on national and international television. These have included: CNN Wolf Blitzer, CNN Deborah Fayereck, CNN Susan Candiotti, NBC- 30, CTN, Fox-61, Vectone TV–UK, Geo TV- Forum, and Voice of America- International.

Dr. Anwar is married to Yusra Anis-Anwar, a specialist in Hypertension and vascular diseases and internal medicine and is father to two sons Taha and Taseen.
